2012 staffing and classes

Planning for 2012—2014 school cycle is well underway. An important part of this planning is developing a strong, supportive and most importantly sustainable staffing model. With variations to enrolments comes variations to plans and this year is no different to many I have encountered in the past.

I have sought the advice of our P&C, your representative body on various staffing models and sources of funding. After serious consideration and conversations with our staff and colleague principals I have decided to fund all staffing and class structures from our government 'Global' allocation.

It was my wish to have announced classes and structures this year for 2012, however, this will not be possible.

My priorities are to ensure that the students in our school are placed in class structures that maximize the resources and learning outcomes for every child. To that end, all students will be placed in classes on Monday, 30th, January 2012. It is important to note that these classes (as in every NSW DEC school) are temporary until the principal receives final confirmation of enrolment and funding (18th, February).

I would like to take this opportunity to thank our P&C executive for their advice and support in this matter.
