

Cool Kids Group Program for Anxiety

Cool Kids is a structured, skills-based program that teaches children and adolescents how to better manage their anxiety. It involves participation of both the child or adolescent and their parents, and focuses on teaching clear and practical skills. The program has been continually evaluated and developed through research programs run at Macquarie University since 1993. The research indicates that approximately 80% of young people who complete Cool Kids programs show significant improvement in areas such as confidence, number of friends and involvement in extracurricular activities, school attendance and academic achievement. Additionally, the research indicates reductions in worry, fear, shyness and family distress following participation in Cool Kids programs.

Topics covered include:

- · Learning about emotions and anxiety
- · Learning to think more realistically using 'Detective Thinking'
- How parents can help
- Fighting fear by gradually facing fear ('Stepladders')
- Problem-solving
- Assertiveness and dealing with bullying

The Cool Kids program is designed for children aged 7 to 17 years, with slightly different versions for primary school children and high school children. There is also a Cool Little Kids program designed to help parents of shy or inhibited younger children learn how to increase their child's confidence and reduce the likelihood that they will develop anxiety later in childhood.

Cool Kids programs run in a group format, between 6pm and 8pm on weeknights for 10 weeks during school terms. Cool Little Kids groups are conducted during business hours, with parents only. Prior to allocation to a group, children and their parents will need to attend a thorough assessment to determine suitability of the Cool Kids program to the child's specific difficulties. Once suitability has been established, the family will be allocated to the next available group (usually in the following school term, subject to availability).

Medicare rebates for group programs may apply if the child has a Mental Health Care Plan from their paediatrician or GP.
